

Union Shop Agreement At Koppers

A union shop agreement is in effect today for the first time at the Koppers Co. tie plant, Carbondale.

The agreement is contained in a new one-year contract signed Saturday afternoon with Local 12176, United Mine Workers of America District 50.

The contract also provides a flat across-the-board increase of eight cents an hour to the plant's 62 hourly rate employees, Manager Howard Twitchell said. Other terms of the former contract were renewed.

Local 12176 has represented Koppers workers since 1941, President Shelly Chappell said. The local was assisted in its latest negotiations by Smithie Weathers, District 50 representative.
